Vivien A. Schmidt is Jean Monnet Professor of European Integration and Associate Chair in the Department of International Relations at Boston University. She was formerly Professor of Political Science and Management at the University of Massachusetts Boston; has held visiting professorships at the Institut d'Études Politiques in Paris, the European University Institute in Florence, the Max Planck Institute in Cologne, the Universities of Paris V and X, and the Universities of Lille I and II; and has been a visiting scholar at the Center for European Studies at Harvard University, and a Visitor and Fulbright fellow at Nuffield College, Oxford University.

Past head of the European Union Studies Association-USA, she directs European Studies activities at Boston University, and was founding Director of the European Studies Program at the University of Massachusetts,

Vivien A. Schmidt has written widely in the areas of European political economy, institutions and democracy, and political theory. Her most recent book is *Democracy in Europe: The EU and National Politics* (Oxford: Oxford University Press, 2006).
